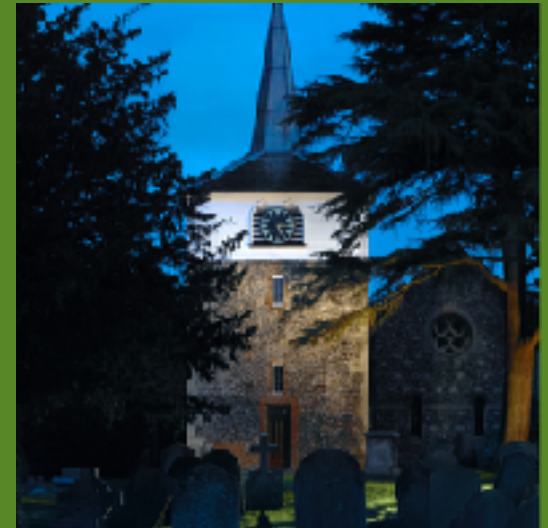

Thames Ditton's church dates from Norman times and over the centuries generations of families have worshipped, been baptised, married or held funerals here. Many are buried in our churchyard or have their ashes interred in our beautiful Garden of Remembrance.
